



**STANDARD FLOWER SHOW
DIVISION II - DESIGN ENTRIES**
General Guidelines and Rules (2021)
Poway Valley Garden Club

Division II, Design Entries, contains two Sections: Table Artistry Designs and Designer Choice Designs. Guidelines for these Entries are outlined in the current Flower Show Schedule.

General Guidelines

1. Advance registration is required.
2. The exhibitor is required to conform to the design size, description and limitations as outlined in the current Flower Show Schedule.
3. Class titles are intended to stimulate imagination and do not need to be taken literally.
4. The designer has the freedom to choose Traditional or Creative style with any design unless specified differently by the Schedule.
5. All designs must contain some plant material. Plant material in a design need not be grown by the exhibitor.
6. Fresh plant material may not be treated to enhance the natural fresh condition of material in any manner.
7. Dried or glycerolized plant material or contrived flowers made from recognizable plant material are permitted except where prohibited by the Schedule.
8. No artificial flowers, foliage, fruit or vegetables are permitted. Cut fruit or vegetables are not allowed.
9. All plant material used in the design must be identified on a 5" x 7" card, provided by the exhibitor and included with the entry form.
10. Any religious symbols must be displayed in a respectful manner and in accordance with policies of local organizations.
11. The American and other national flags are not permitted.
12. Staging panels and/or underlays are permitted in all classes.
13. A white table cover and skirting will be provided by the club.
14. A Class designated for a novice means for an exhibitor who has never won a blue ribbon in the Design Division of an NGC sponsored Flower Show.
15. If a registered exhibitor is unable to fulfill the assignment, it is his/her responsibility to contact a show official and find a replacement.
